



CODE OF CONDUCT MBAT

Please read carefully below and return the document signed to the HEC MBAT team.

1. MBAT Philosophy

The philosophy of the HEC MBA Tournament ("MBAT") is to blend sport with culture and education. The ultimate goals of the MBAT are to:

- Have a good time
- Play sports in a fun environment
- Share experiences with other MBA students

2. Expectations

Participants in the MBAT promise and are expected to respect the spirit of **fair play, non-violence**, as well as **good sportsmanship**, and behave accordingly **on and off the field**, which includes:

- Sport fields
- Parties
- Hotels
- Restaurants
- Buses
- ... and any other places, public or private, where the image or reputation of the MBAT or HEC School of Management may be at stake

3. Responsibilities

HEC School of Management will not be held responsible for any misconduct of any participant, and it is under the **responsibility of the Schools coordinators** to inform about, and make sure the present Code of Conduct is respected by their participants.

4. Sanctions

In case any participant, from any school, shows evidence of misconduct degrading the image of the MBAT, the HEC MBAT staff reserves its right to:

- **Expel the individual** from one or all of the MBAT events, without any refund
- **Refuse the whole School's participation to next year's MBAT**
- **Inform the concerned School's administration about the incident and the measures taken.**

Examples of misconducts liable to such treatments are fighting, harassing, breaking material, stealing, damaging of third parties' property, either at HEC or in the buses, hotels, or restaurants that will serve the MBAT during the event.

In addition, participants' attention is called to the fact that it is the responsibility of each individual to keep the campus clean throughout the event.

5. Special Fair Play Prize

A special prize will be awarded to the School which demonstrates the greatest enthusiasm and fair play throughout the event.
